This year's Season of Bliss will open with the most whimsical and enchanted ballet of all-time, *Coppélia.* From 16 – 19 March at The Esplanade Theatre, audiences will be treated to a colourful spectacular of joyous dancing.

"Coppélia became part of Singapore Dance Theatre's performance repertoire early on in the company's history. It is a narrative ballet that possesses authentic charm, artistic quality and visual delights for the audience. Coppélia endures as one of the most well- known ballets in the lexicon of ballet and, having established its legacy in repertoires all over the world, it leaves a responsibility in presentation and performance to us to attain. SDT last presented Coppélia in our 25th Anniversary season and what we bring to the ballet this time around, is the same delightful structure, plus more confidence and quality in how we show ourselves onstage to the audience. A ballet does not need to change for it to grow and develop artistically. Coppélia, along with The Nutcracker, has a narrative drawn from a story by E.T.A. Hoffmann and part of the enjoyment for the dancers is dancing through the story and using their abilities as dancers in acting, technique and drawing out all the delights possible for our audiences. It is an experience to be remembered." says artistic director Janek Schergen.

This three-act ballet tells the light-hearted story of the mysterious Dr Coppélius who owns a beautiful life-sized puppet, *Coppélia*. A village youth named Franz, betrothed to the beautiful Swanilda becomes infatuated with *Coppélia*, not knowing that she just a doll. The magic and fun begins when *Coppélia* springs to life!

*Coppélia* is one of SDT's favourite full-length classical ballets from our repertoire. This euphoric ballet was first performed by SDT in 1995 with staging by Colin Peasley of The Australian Ballet. With original choreography by Arthur St. Léon, *Coppélia* is staged with additional choreography by Janek Schergen. Be enthralled by this magical production that is set to music by Léo Delibes. *Coppélia* was last performed in 2013, so don't miss the opportunity to catch it this time!

## SYNOPSIS

### <u>Act I</u>

In an idyllic village in Galica, everyone is preparing to celebrate the Festival of the Bells. A beautiful girl, Swanilda, has been courted by the most charming boy in the village, Franz, in hopes that they will marry. He is also fascinated with the daughter of the village toy-maker, Dr. Coppélius. She is named Coppélia, and sits every day on the balcony of her father's house reading.

### <u>Act II</u>

Swanilda and her girlfriends cautiously enter into Dr. Coppélius' workshop and finds it full of life size dolls. In attempting to find Coppélia, they set all the dolls in motion and are delighted with the results. It is revealed by Swanilda that Coppélia is nothing more than a beautiful doll herself. Just as this happens, Dr. Coppélius returns and chases them all from the house. Swanilda has hidden herself in Coppelia's alcove and to trick Dr. Coppélius, dresses herself up to masquerade as the beautiful doll.

#### Act III

The following day, the village celebrates the Festival of the Bells. The end brings calm to the village and all the couples that marry on this day will be especially blessed.

# THE COMPANY

SDT was founded in 1988 by Goh Soo Khim and Anthony Then. Since then, SDT has developed into Singapore's premiere professional dance company comprising. In the course of each year, the Company performs six main seasons, including the widely popular Ballet Under the Stars at the Fort Canning Park, two full length classics, Masterpiece in Motion which brings together three works of the finest international choreography and Passages Contemporary Season.

As an ambassador for dance and for Singapore, the company aims to be an internationally well-regarded professional dance company that is known for its unique ability to shine in classical, neo-classical and contemporary repertoire with works that are timeless and inspiring.

The Company's repertoire ranges from classical to contemporary ballet, from renowned choreographers like Choo-San Goh, George Balanchine, Jiri Kylian, Stanton Welch, Natalie Weir, Val Caniparoli, Graham Lustig, David Dawson, Jorma Elo, Edmund Stripe, Kinsun Chan, Edwaard Liang, Nils Christe, Toru Shimazaki, Christina Chan, Ma Cong, and most recently Timothy Harbour, resident choreographer of Australian Ballet.

In 2008, Janek Schergen was appointed as the Artistic Director of SDT, after his extensive involvement with SDT since its inception years in 1988. Under his leadership, the Company has made new achievements in the international and Singapore dance arena. In the last eight years, the Company has added 27 world premieres and 16 company premieres to the repertoire, in addition to numerous revivals of the existing Company's repertoire. Janek is also the Artistic Director of the Choo-San Goh & H. Robert Magee Foundation which oversees the licensing and production of Choo San Goh's ballets and the annual Choo San Goh Awards for Choreography.

SDT actively reaches out to the public to create greater awareness of dance through outreach to schools with its Arts Education Programme, Dance Appreciation Series (jointly presented with Esplanade Co.), Adults Dance Classes, Scholars Programme for students considering dancing as a career, SDT choreographic workshop focusing on local emerging talents and One @ the Ballet, an initiative to help the public gain a better understanding of the different aspects of dance.

In 2013, SDT moved to a new premise with four state of the art studios. Additionally the Company will be enhancing efforts in Education and Outreach, bringing greater awareness and appreciation for dance to a wider audience.
