In celebration of Singapore Dance Theatre's 30 years of history, this season presents some of the most compelling and exquisite works of the year. An evening of ballet gems, the company's 30th anniversary gala performance will see four works – Timothy Harbour's world premiere of *Linea Adora* which is created especially for SDT's 30th anniversary, the company premiere of Nils Christe's SYNC, as well as Choo-San Goh's *Double Contrasts* and the pas de deux from *Configurations*. Happening on **27 & 28 July**, this international repertory season will be held at the **Esplanade Theatre**.

More than a stunning repertory set to stage, this performance is a celebration of milestones, memories, and moments! This will be a wonderfully treasured weekend for the company, its loyal supporters, donors, and friends.

"In 1987, when the two co-founders of Singapore Dance Theatre, Anthony Then and Goh Soo Khim spoke to Choo San Goh about the establishment of SDT, Choo-San instructed me to help them. He asked me to set his ballet, *Beginnings* for the first SDT performance. In addition, I taught them a classical divertissement from the ballet *Raymonda*, to conclude the evening. It was a special moment in time to see the launching of a new artistic endeavour. To have been involved with SDT for 30 years has been an honour, because of the desires and intentions of the two co-founders and their inspiration have now grown to fulfilment. These performances, with the ballets from choreographers Choo-San Goh, Timothy Harbour and Nils Christe, links to those first moments of SDT's formation in a full circle. My hope is that the original intention for the establishment of SDT will grow and strengthen more and more over time and that the most exciting time is yet ahead of us." says Artistic Director Janek Schergen.

Double Contrasts

Music Francis Poulenc (Concerto in D Minor for Two Pianos and Orchestra)

Double Contrasts is both elegant and classical in dance form. The two sets of dancers reflect the two solo pianists; one set being full and youthful enthusiasm and the other more sophisticated in nature. The work has energy, wit and style. The dancers exude chic and elegance in their formal costumes. Double Contrasts presents many technical challenges for the dancers. It is fast, as are all Choo-San's ballets at their heart and its leaves the audience exhilarated. One of Choo San's first ballets that stood the test of time and that is performed on a consistent basis from its premiere till now.

Music Samuel Barber (Concerto for Piano & Orchestra, Opus 38)

Configurations stood as a very impressive piece of choreography. It was a tribute to the durable values of Choo- San's craft and art. There is a definite dramatic subtext, not quite a story, but a portrait of personalities and relationships. Two people who are attracted to one another, cross each other's paths, and get involved, but at the same time, remain self-absorbed in worlds that utterly diverge.

Originally created for the Washington Ballet, *SYNC* has been successfully performed by 14 companies in Europe, USA and Australia. Standing for "syncronisation", "syncopation" and "to be in sync", *SYNC* was created to Salgari by Italian composer Ludovico Einaudi. The music is partly very quick, percussive and propulsive, but also lyrical and poetic. The large truss gives a "high-tech" feeling to the piece. It is not only there as decoration, therefore adding an interesting element to the choreography.

THE COMPANY

SDT was founded in 1988 by Goh Soo Khim and Anthony Then. Since then, SDT has developed into Singapore's premiere professional dance company comprising of 32 dancers plus apprentices. In the course of each year, the Company performs six main seasons, including the widely popular Ballet Under the Stars at the Fort Canning Park, two full length classics, Masterpiece in Motion which brings together three works of the finest international choreography and Passages Contemporary Season.

The Company's repertoire ranges from 19th century traditional classical to contemporary works, from renowned choreographers like Choo-San Goh, George Balanchine, Stanton Welch, Natalie Weir, Val Caniparoli, Edmund Stripe, Kinsun Chan, Edwaard Liang, Nils Christe, Toru Shimazaki, Christina Chan, Ma Cong, and most recently Timothy Harbour, resident choreographer of Australian Ballet.

In 2008, Janek Schergen was appointed as the Artistic Director of SDT, after his extensive involvement with SDT since its inception years in 1988. Under his leadership, the Company has made new achievements in the international and Singapore dance arena. In the last ten years, the Company has added 28 world premieres and 18 company premieres and new productions to the repertoire, in addition to numerous revivals of the existing Company's repertoire. Janek is also the Artistic Director of the Choo-San Goh & H. Robert Magee Foundation which oversees the licensing and production of Choo San Goh's ballets and the annual Choo San Goh Awards for Choreography.

SDT has captivated audiences in Malaysia, Indonesia, Philippines, Cambodia, Hong Kong, Mexico, China, Australia, France, United States, London, and Switzerland. The Company has taken part and has performed in numerous international festivals and events, such as Le Temps d'Aimer la Danse a Biarritz in France, Mexico's Festival Internacional Cervantino, Chang Mu Arts Festival in Korea, Philippines Festival of Dance, and was part of the Victorian Arts Centre's Made to Move subscription series. SDT tours Kuala Lumpur and Penang annually, and has seen a growth in its dedicated support to the company.

SDT actively reaches out to the public to create greater awareness of dance through outreach to schools with its Arts Education Programme, Dance Appreciation Series (jointly presented with Esplanade Co.), Adults Dance Classes, Scholars Programme for students considering dancing as a career, SDT Choreographic Workshop focusing on local emerging talents and One @ the Ballet, an initiative to help the public gain a better understanding of the different aspects of dance.

In 2013, SDT moved to a new premise with four state of the art studios. Since, the Company has enhanced efforts in Education and Outreach, bringing greater awareness and appreciation for dance to a wider audience. We also cater the Ballet Associate's Course (BAC) for students who intend to develop their dance skills and techniques. Last year, we introduced Adopt an Audience to make arts accessible for everyone, including the low-income, underprivileged, and disabled in our society.
