Singapore Dance Theatre (SDT) will open its' 2019 season with *Don Quixote* from **7 – 10 March 2019**, at the Esplanade Theatre. Selected by Dance Europe Critic's Choice as one of the Best Premieres of the year, SDT's company premiere of *Don Quixote* garnered rave reviews and fronted Dance Europe's cover in January 2015!

"The *Don Quixote* production we begin the season with was first presented by SDT in December 2014. The decision to produce such an important ballet signalled a new maturity in the level of SDT, in every element, from the artistry and abilities of the dancers, to the production values necessary to bring such a masterpiece onto the stage. Cynthia Harvey created a magnificent staging for the company, with sets and costumes by Bruce McKinven, and atmospheric lighting from Adrian Tan. Performances grow and mature with repeated presentations and audiences can see more of the uniqueness and detail in every performance. *Don Quixote* is one of the "jewels in the crown" that we possess and a ballet of the greatest joy and artistic sophistication. These performances, now with The Metropolitan Festival Orchestra, are one of the defining aspects of our dancers' talents and a fulfilment of why Singapore Dance Theatre was established in the first place." says Artistic Director Janek Schergen.

SYNOPSIS

Set in Spain, *Don Quixote* tells a story of love, betrayal, and eternal devotion written by Miguel de Cervantes. Kitri, the beautiful daughter of Lorenzo the innkeeper, has fallen in love with Basilio, a poor young barber. However, Kitri's father has every intention on having her marry the wealthy fop, Gamache. The two young lovers resolve to run away, and met Don Quixote, an old knight, and his faithful companion, Sancho Panza, en route to escape. With a series of chivalrous acts, whimsical twists, and proof that love conquers all, Kitri and Basilio finally celebrate their marriage with a grand pas de deux, a glittering showstopper displaying the dazzling feats of partnering.

THE COMPANY

SDT was founded in 1988 by Goh Soo Khim and Anthony Then. Since then, SDT has developed into Singapore's premiere professional dance company comprising of 36 dancers plus trainees. In the course of each year, the Company performs six main seasons, including the widely popular Ballet Under the Stars at the Fort Canning Park, two full length classics, Masterpiece in Motion which brings together three works of the finest international choreography and Passages Contemporary Season.

The Company's repertoire ranges from 19th century traditional classical to contemporary works, from renowned choreographers like Choo-San Goh, George Balanchine, Stanton Welch, Natalie Weir, Val Caniparoli, Edmund Stripe, Kinsun Chan, Edwaard Liang, Nils Christe, Toru Shimazaki, Christina Chan, Ma Cong, Timothy Harbour and most recently, Timothy Rushton.

In 2008, Janek Schergen was appointed as the Artistic Director of SDT, after his extensive involvement with SDT since its inception years in 1988. Under his leadership, the Company has made new achievements in the international and Singapore dance arena. In the last ten years, the Company has added 30 world premieres and 19 company premieres and new productions to the repertoire, in addition to numerous revivals of the existing Company's repertoire. Janek is also the Artistic Director of the Choo-San Goh & H. Robert Magee Foundation which oversees the licensing and production of Choo San Goh's ballets and the annual Choo San Goh Awards for Choreography.

SDT has captivated audiences in Malaysia, Indonesia, Philippines, Cambodia, Hong Kong, Mexico, China, Australia, France, United States, London, and Switzerland. The Company has taken part and has performed in numerous international festivals and events, such as Le Temps d'Aimer la Danse a Biarritz in France, Mexico's Festival Internacional Cervantino, Chang Mu Arts Festival in Korea, Philippines Festival of Dance, and was part of the Victorian Arts Centre's Made to Move subscription series. SDT tours Kuala Lumpur and Penang annually, and has seen a growth in its dedicated support to the company.

SDT actively reaches out to the public to create greater awareness of dance through outreach to schools with its Arts Education Programme, Dance Appreciation Series (jointly presented with Esplanade Co.), Adults Dance Classes, Scholars Programme for students considering dancing as a career, SDT Choreographic Workshop focusing on local emerging talents and One @ the Ballet, an initiative to help the public gain a better understanding of the different aspects of dance.

In 2013, SDT moved to a new premise with four state of the art studios. Since, the Company has enhanced efforts in Education and Outreach, bringing greater awareness and appreciation for dance to a wider audience. We also cater the Ballet Associate's Course (BAC) for students who intend to develop their dance skills and techniques. Last year, we introduced Adopt an Audience to make arts accessible for everyone, including the low-income, underprivileged, and disabled in our society.

In celebration of SDT's 30th Anniversary as well as for the Nation's birthday, SDT's ballet master, Mohamed Noor Sarman choreographed the dance music video for NDP 2018 theme song 'We are Singapore'.
