After much consideration, the management and directors of Singapore Dance Theatre are proud to announce that our performances of *Romeo and Juliet* shall proceed as planned, from Thursday, 5 March, closing Sunday 8 March, at Esplandade Theatre.

In light of the fear surrounding the ongoing CoronaVirus (COVID-19), while aiming to find a silver lining in this present-day reality, Singapore Dance Theatre (SDT) would like to offer great thanks to all patrons with a one-for-one ticket promotion to *Romeo and Juliet*, with effect from today, 13 February.

We hope to promote a cohesive and collaborative front, while resuming normalcy in our everyday lives.

Having stated this, the safety of our patrons is paramount, and SDT would like to encourage everyone to take the necessary precautions to stay safe.

SDT assures all patrons that we will act in accordance with the official advisory from Ministry of Health (MOH), as stated below:

OFFICIAL ADVISORY FROM MINISTRY OF HEALTH

- 1. Carry out temperature screening.
- 2. Look out for respiratory symptoms such as cough or runny nose, and deny entry to unwell individuals.
- 3. Remind participants not to attend if they have recent travel history to mainland China or are under leave of absence, and require travel declaration, if possible.
- 4. Ensure that event venues are ventilated and are adequately equipped with facilities for hand washing.
- 5. Increase the frequency of cleaning of commonly used areas.
- 6. Maintain a registration list of participants, if practical.

ESPLANADE THEATRE'S PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES

- 1. Thermal screening at the entrance of the theatre for all ticket holders. Patrons are advised to arrive at the venue earlier than the stipulated performance time to give leeway for this screening.
- 2. Patrons with confirmed temperatures of above 38°C will be asked to seek medical attention and provide their contact, travel history, and health details.
- 3. Increased cleaning and sanitisation of theatre venues.

SDT'S ADVISORY & NOTICE

1. Travel Advisory

We seek the cooperation of all patrons who are unwell, who have travelled to China in the recent weeks, or who have come in contact to suspected/confirmed cases of COVID-19 to refrain from attending the events.

2. Ongoing Event / Cancellation

SDT performances held at the Esplanade Theatre will not be cancelled. SDT and Esplanade Theatres will continue to monitor the situation closely and adjust the measures accordingly as needed. Should there be any cancellations, it will be announced via SDT's Facebook and Instagram.

3. Action Upon DORSCON RED Status

In the (unlikely) event that Singapore enters DORSCON - RED, patrons may request for a full refund by writing in to ticketing@singaporedancetheatre.com by 31 March 2020.
